The aim of the training programmes is for the beneficiaries to acquire additional knowledge, skills in the field of innovative technologies to improve the effectiveness of environmental protection and the efficient use of resources. Participation in the examinations to obtain the certification according to the ISO 17024 standard, which guarantees professional rights at European and international level, will contribute positively to the enhancement of employment.
