### Ormideia Community Council joined the journey to Climate Adaptation

Ormideia is the latest Community who received funding through the <u>Scheme for Strengthening the Reselience</u> <u>and Adaptation of Community Councils to Climate Change</u>.

With an application under the Category B' of Investments -Investments for Strengthening the Adaptation and Resilience of Communities to Climate Change-, Ormideia Community aims to develop a new Agiospilio Square, nearby a recently-built residential area and two public schools.

Given its flooding history, which sets it as a Community of Potentially Serious Flood Risk, Ormideia intends to redevelop the existing area with permeable paving, and install infiltration wells to collect rainwater. In addition, they plan to enhance the greenery with tree plantings for natural shading, and install urban equipment, such as benches, to increase visitor traffic to the area.



### **European Energy Communities Facility | 1st Call for Proposals**

The Cyprus Energy Agency, National Expert of the <u>EU Energy Communities Facility</u> -also known as ENERCOM Facility-, wants to raise awareness about the 1st Call for Proposals that opened on June 2nd and will remain in force until September 30th, 2025.

The ENERCOM Facility is for businesses, citizens and Local Authorities, who are interested in developing their own Energy Communities. Through the Call, eligible applicants can secure 45000 lump sum grants and access to a tailored capacity-building programme, to develop their sustainable business plans.

Interested applicants are adviced to submit their proposals online, through the Facility's website, after carefully reading the Call's documents. Within this framework, our Agency is organising an online Info Session in Greek, on July 3rd, 2025, from 11 to 12 o'clock EET. ### **Renewable Energy Sources**

On May 30, a high-level meeting marked the official launch of the *Cross-border sustainable renewable energy* acceleration in *Ukraine* project, a key initiative supporting Ukraine's green recovery, as well as its accelerated integration with the EU.

The project aims to identify the most suitable areas for the development of renewable energy investments in the country -places where infrastructure, environmental conditions, and political frameworks enable rapid and sustainable growth. These will be identified based on the need for cross-border cooperation, bringing together the efforts of neighbouring EU countries, and Moldova.

**Sustainable Cities - Sustainable Mobility** 

The Irish Western Development Commission released its *Sustainable Mobility Index* for 2024, highlighting the transport progress made in 40 rural towns. The report measures accessibility, connectivity, and sustainability in transport-related services -key factors in reducing carbon emissions and ensuring social inclusion across rural communities.

The Index evaluates 30 indicators across 3 main themes: readiness for low-carbon transition, access to social services, and access to employment. These include the availability of public and active travel infrastructure, affordability, and how well communities are linked to essential services and job opportunities.

## **Energy Efficiency**

Dubai signed an agreement with Etihad Energy Services Company (Etihad ESCO), to launch the final phase of its airport-wide lighting retrofit project -a key milestone in its ongoing sustainability agenda, and a major step towards energy-efficient operations at both of its airports.

Combined with the first phase completed earlier and covering 150,000 lighting units, the project will upgrade more than 330,000 lighting units in total, making it one of the most extensive airport lighting retrofit initiatives in the region. The project is expected to cut annual energy consumption by 47 million kWh, which is equivalent to powering over 4,300 households for an entire year.
